

## Over the hooks report - cattle

Market information provided by MLA's National Livestock Reporting Service

Victoria report date 13 May 2011

Cattle rates have come back and the heavy weights and all export grades were hardest hit with most being 20c to 30c/kg cwt lower. This follows on from the cheaper saleyard rates of last week. Vealers and light to medium weight yearlings are mostly unchanged to 10c/kg cwt easier. The main reason is the increase in supply as producers offload due to colder temperatures and not wanting to carry cattle through winter if no more condition can be added. Also the increase in turn off from northern states is having an impact as access to the previously flooded areas opens up.
