Numbers were back on last week's sale and the yarding of cattle was of fair to good quality, with all usual cattle buyers in attendance. Bullocks held firm on the previous weeks rates, while medium weight grown steers gained 4c/kg. There were mainly plainer sorts of grown heifers on offer and they sold to 2c/kg dearer. Cows were mixed in quality.

A few heavy weight yearling heifers sold to 153c and averaged 150c, down 15c/kg. Medium weight grown steers averaged around 173c, up 4c/kg. Good bullocks reached 177c and averaged 171c, unchanged on last weeks averages. Heavy weight grown heifers made to 164c and averaged 162c, up 2c/kg. A small sample of full mouth manufacturing gained 2c to average 168c/kg.

Medium weight 3 score cows earned to 143c and averaged 134c, down 3c, while medium weight 4 score cows hit 153c and averaged 146c, down 4c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score cows topped at 152c and averaged 149c, down 7c/kg. Heavy bulls averaged 152c/kg, unchanged on last weeks rates.
