

Chairman AUS-MEAT Limited

As Chairman of AUS-MEAT you would need to be passionate about the Australian meat and livestock industry and have experience in previous roles on Boards or Committees closely associated with meat processing or livestock production.

The role is ideally suited to a person with demonstrated leadership skills, directors responsibility in the maintenance of governance frameworks to ensure strategic and governance objectives have been met, combined with an ability to build professional leadership with diverse stakeholders including government, sector organisations and peak bodies.
