We currently have a permanent full time position available for a Livestock Hand in our Livestock Team.

Key responsibilities include:

- All aspects of cattle handling from induction of new cattle to dispatch of finished cattle.
- All aspects of animal health and welfare management from pen riding and treatments through to post-mortems.
- Data recording and input for all activities.
- Inventory control and stocktaking of all livestock products.
- Cleaning & maintenance of facilities.
- Any other duties that may be required by the business.

Ideally the successful candidate will possess the following skills and attributes:
