The Positions

Reporting to the Station Manager, the successful applicants will be responsible for the general day to day operations of the 45 000 ha Mitchell grass downs property and also cover for the station manager when absent from the property. Each assistant manager will have responsibility for half of the property and so have autonomy in decision making in relation to livestock, waters, lick, etc.

The initial role of these positions will be to implement an RCS designed water and fencing intensification plan. The successful applicants will then manage the expected increase in herd size by the efficient utilisation of the new paddocks created by rotational grazing. Applicants should be confident, knowledgeable and experienced with pasture management, mustering and processing large mobs of cattle (up to 4000 head). You will also be required to undertake general maintenance, fencing and water runs.
