SGB(A)A are currently seeking to appoint a Field Director, who possesses a strong knowledge of the beef cattle industry and proficiency in cattle selection. You will be one of two Field Directors employed by the Association with the responsibility for implementing the breed's "standard of excellence" across all recorded animals and promotional and educational activities.

The successful candidate will be a highly skilled communicator with a proven track record of success and skills to engage in the digital world. The position will be offered on a contract basis, where the candidate will cover their allocated zones, mainly between February and August each year.

Based from your place of residence you will be self-motivated, a positive team player and willing to travel during these contracted months with over 90% of the classification numbers conducted in QLD and NSW. At times the position will require travel outside of these states.

The candidate will report to the General Manager but will be required to provide an open line of communication between members and office staff to ensure all classification requirements are met.
