- Apply innovative and creative methods to develop materials and briefs to influence / communicate complex issues, value propositions and or changing requirements.
- Develop tailored communication pathways to support the extension of R&D outcomes and positive benefits of LiveCorp and LEP program services for the industry, exporters and the Australian community.
- Support the livestock export industry peak council to ensure that all industry participants, the Australian community
 and stakeholders in overseas markets are aware of the Australian livestock export industry's commitment and
 progress towards achieving the industry reform strategy.
- Ensure that communications are appropriate, effective and inform government and industry stakeholders of the livestock export sector.
- Support improved awareness and understanding of the livestock export industry by the Australian community.

- a tertiary qualification in science, agricultural science, or communications
- experience in agricultural or commodity communications, and exposure to dealing with social license to operate issues would be well regarded
- very strong writing skills with the ability to transform technical information into user-friendly material, preferably with a background in science
- advanced interpersonal skills with a range of stakeholders, including management, government and industry members
- a hands-on, delivery focused, proactive, organised approach with the ability to actively listen and communicate in a clear, concise and logical manner
