



STATION MANAGER - Stirling Lotusvale Station Gulf of Carpentaria, QLD

Located 100km north east of Normanton in the Gulf of Carpentaria, Stirling Lotusvale Station is the backgrounding property forming an integral part of the Gulf Coast Agricultural Company. Carrying approximately 15,000 head, with a large turn off this property requires a Station Manager with proven skills and experience in weight management in both background and sales presentation scenarios.

A growing large scale, high grade Brahman stud operation is located on the property, primarily managed by the Pastoral Inspector and Stud Registrar, however, the processing and maintenance will fall under the responsibility of the Stirling Station manager, so any stud experience will be favourable.

The successful applicant will be responsible for delivering a structured turnoff and intake program in conjunction with the Pastoral Inspector, utilising primarily permanent staff supplemented with contractors from other properties as operations dictate, to an agreed budget and timetable. The role will require a trustworthy individual who can demonstrate the following:

- Excellent horse and cattle handling skills, with a strong focus on Low Stress Stock handling techniques
- The highest standards of vehicle, equipment and machinery upkeep and maintenance
- Proven communication and strong leadership traits
- Meticulous record keeping ability
- Willingness to learn new concepts, and adapt them to a team environment
- Strong Computer skills
- Commitment to a solid Workplace Health and Safety program
- Ability to work autonomously in a remote environment
- Show a keen desire to build a strong culture of education, staff retention, personal development and be a team player
- Manual Car License
