

Management Trainee

Background

The newly expanded 20200 SCU feedlot at Jondaryan QLD is seeking a trainee with the view to develop long term management capacity within this supply chain of over 25,000 bodies each year.

The Role

This position will be designed to build the practical capabilities of the candidate across all sections of the feedlot business in order to effectively take on a leadership role within the business on completion of the program. The selected candidate will be exposed to the Kerwee business operations during a structured training program over 24 months to construct a skill set enabling them to forge a long term management career. During this time the focus areas will include:

- Livestock
- Feeding and Commodities
- Maintenance
- Administration and Quality Assurance
- Production
- Sales and Marketing

Training

During the 24 month program, the successful candidate will undertake both internal and external training to assist them in their daily role. Internal training will include learning every facet of the Kerwee Group business, to gain a greater understanding of how the supply chain operates. External training will include (but not limited to):

- Statutory requirements (eg. First Aid, ChemCert etc)
- Understanding and Auditing Quality Assurance Systems
- Effective Communication and Leadership Skills
