

Intensive Irrigation and Crop Manager

Pardoo Beef Corporation (PBC) is an irrigated agriculture project in the Pilbara region of WA. PBC encompasses breeding and fattening of Wagyu cattle, an extensive crop program and pastoral operations. PBC will have 1500 hectares of crops under irrigation by 2020 using groundwater from sustainable regional water resources.

The Irrigation and Crop manager will play a key role on the executive team, contributing to strategy and development of this state-significant agricultural project. This position reports to the CEO and is responsible for managing teams in three different areas: irrigation/cropping, construction and earthmoving.

Applicants for this position should have the following experience and skills:

- Experience in intensive irrigation and crop management: crop establishment, agronomy, machinery operation and maintenance and fodder conservation
- Broad understanding of pivot irrigation
- Exceptional communication and interpersonal skills to manage multiple teams and engage with relevant industry stakeholders
- Excellent record-keeping abilities with high level computer skills
- Ability to prioritise
- Demonstrated understanding and implementation of OH&S practices

This is a live-in position based on Pardoo Station, 160 kilometres east of Port Hedland, WA near the coast. There is the possibility for work on the station for someone with a partner. Please note there is no access to local schooling.
