LEADING HAND:

An experienced Leading Hand with demonstrated abilities in livestock handling skills and highly experienced in Inductions and Drafting is required to join the team at Wambo Feedlot.

Your main responsibilities will be:

- Oversee the day-to-day running of the Induction Centre
- Inducting and Drafting cattle
- Continual monitoring of cattle health in line with our strong emphasis on animal welfare

The successful applicant will need to have proven experience in the following:

- General livestock handling skills
- Induction of cattle to the Feedlot
- Drafting and moving cattle to and from pens
- Ability to diagnose animal health symptoms
- Pregnancy testing experience not necessary however, highly desirable

In order to be considered for this role, you must:

- Be experienced in FY3000 & StockAid (or similar) programs
- Be confident in the administration of animal health products
- Be able to demonstrate general cattle husbandry tasks
- Show initiative and willingness to acquire new skills, as on-the-job training will be provided
- Be prepared to work within a 5 on 2 off roster

Furthermore, it would be highly advantageous if you are:

- Competent in data recording and reporting
- A good communicator with the manager and your team

PEN RIDER & STOCKPERSON:

Experienced Pen Riders and Stockpersons with demonstrated abilities in livestock handling skills are required to join the livestock handling staff at

Your main responsibilities at the Feedlot will be:

- Drafting and moving cattle
- Continual monitoring of cattle health in line with our strong emphasis on animal welfare

The successful applicant will need to have proven experience in the following:

- General livestock handling skills
- Drafting
- Moving cattle to and from pens

- Ability to diagnose animal health symptoms
- Competent horsemanship and riding skills is a must (for Pen Rider position vacant)

In order to be considered for this role, you must:

- Be able to supply a minimum of 2 horses suitable for the position and own tack - for Pen Rider position (please note – it is company policy that all horses entering Wambo Feedlot be Hendra Vaccinated)
- Be confident in the administration of animal health products
- Be able to demonstrate general cattle husbandry tasks
- Show initiative and willingness to acquire new skills, as on-the-job training will be provided
- Be prepared to work within a 10 on 4 off roster

Furthermore, it would be highly advantageous (but not essential) if you are:

- Competent in data recording and reporting
- A good communicator with the manager and your team

Our staff receive regular training in livestock nutrition and welfare. Wambo Feedlot also provide shoeing and a fortnightly horse allowance.
