 For example, seeding, in-crop applications, harvest, summer crop planting and corporate administration.
- 2nd year placement at one farm aggregation at the discretion of Lawson Grains.
- An experienced Farm Manager will be assigned as a mentor for the duration of the graduate's placement.
- The graduate would be highly regarded for any permanent positions that become available during or at the completion of the final year.
- This is a paid position with accommodation (sometimes shared) available on farm and Lawson Grains will cover the cost of relocation around the business during the entire program.
