Pardoo Beef Corporation is an irrigated agriculture project that encompasses breeding and fattening of Wagyu cattle, an extensive crop program and pastoral operations. PBC will have 1500 hectares of crops under irrigation by 2020 using groundwater from sustainable regional water resources.

The mechanic position is an extremely varied role, so we are looking for someone who is an energetic self-starter. Duties will include the service and repair of a large fleet of vehicles and machinery: Light vehicles, trucks and trailers, tractors, farm machinery, generators, earthmoving equipment (grader, dozer, excavator, loader, dump truck), water bores, telehandlers, etc.

The station is located on the coast about 1.5 hours from Port Hedland, WA. There are about 25 other staff members working on the station with seasonal increases from March to October as the station also has a tourist park on the property.
