Our business has an exciting opportunity for an experienced and highly motivated Bore Runner to join our team assisting in the management of our water resources for our beef cattle operation in the Gascoyne Junction / Pilbara Area, Western Australia.

Reporting to the Pastoral Operations Managers, the candidate will be responsible for all aspects of bore running and maintenance, including maintaining and cleaning pumps (both solar and diesel as well as windmills), checking water points and maintain water distribution points. You may be required to complete some general station maintenance, however waters are the main priority.

We are seeking employees who are looking for a career in the Agricultural Industry. Applicants with a proactive, positive and can-do attitude are invited to apply to join our TPC team. TPC employs staff from a diverse range of backgrounds with a variety of knowledge, skills and abilities.

#### Key Duties & Responsibilities:

Duties will include, but are not limited to:

- Responsible for water maintenance across the station
- Assist with the implementation of our water supply upgrades projects
- Observation and maintenance of watering points
- Travelling between water points in a 4WD vehicle
- 4WD vehicle and tools provided for daily work duties
- Maintenance of 4WD vehicle, small diesel pumps and spare parts
- Maintenance of Mono pump systems, solar pumps
- At each water source (bore) check and maintain the following: tank level, tank fences, troughs and motors.
- Reporting any issues back to the Operations Manager and Livestock Manager
- Keep records in writing of: bores checked, level of water at each turkey next, number of cattle at each trough, maintenance on fences, troughs and motors
- Prepare, maintain and communicate reports to assist with business analysis and with meeting strategic objectives.
- Assisting elsewhere on the property if required
- Perform your job in a safe manner in line with TPCs safety programs and procedures.
- Promote and comply with quality assurance, company systems and legislative obligations.
- General station maintenance.
