R&D committee positions available in Queensland NABRC Regions

The North Australia Beef Research Council Inc. (NABRC) is an independent, Incorporated Association established in 1992 to provide recommendations on Research, Development & Adoption (RD&A) priorities and planning for grass-fed beef producers throughout northern Australia. Similar organisations now operate in southern and western Australia.

NABRC is committed to building industry and organisational capability and is seeking Expressions of Interest for:

Producer committee members (several positions) across the six Queensland Regional Beef Research Committees (RBRCs)

Working closely with their respective Regional Committee Chair, producer committee members provide the critical link between RD&A providers and the needs of grass-fed beef producers.

Positions are open to grass-fed beef producers who reside in the region for which they are applying. Selection will be based on the following criteria:

1. Demonstrated commercial beef experience;
2. Strong interest in beef production RD&A;
3. Detailed knowledge of beef cattle production in their region;
4. Capability and a willingness to take a leadership role to collate RD&A priorities on behalf of their region and act as industry and community advocates on grass-fed beef RD&A issues; and
5. Capacity to attend two face-to-face meetings in the region a year.

NB: Producer RBRC committee members receive a daily sitting fee to attend meetings plus reimbursement of travel and accommodation/meals.
