This position is for a mature, experienced & highly capable couple that can handle a high level of responsibility.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Ensuring the highest standards of welfare for a herd of approx. 10,000 head of Santa Cross breeder cows in addition to any other livestock on the station, at all times.
- Managing all aspects of the daily running of the station including development of water infrastructure & input into the station's mustering program.
- Supervision of all staff & any contractors on the station including caravan park & fuel stop with small store. Partner expected to manage store/caravan park/fuel and in busy Grey Nomad season employ staff for help in cleaning amenities block, watering gardens & serving tourists.
- Ensuring all station machinery & equipment is regularly kept clean, maintained & serviced.
- Maintain a clean and tidy complex and work area, always comply with safe work practices and enforce a culture of safety focused behaviour to ensure safety of all persons on the station.
