ROLE

A Lead Knife Hand is required for a new state-of-the-art abattoir just nearing completion close to Shanghai in China. The abattoir is set up to process only imported Australian cattle, and our client wants the leadership team to be from Australia to ensure consistency in the processing systems to supply unique Australian beef to the China market.

DESCRIPTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Reporting directly to the Operations Director, this position involves processing of whole cattle carcasses into designated portions, with a high level of accuracy and care, to meet order requirements. As this is a leadership role the candidate must be able to demonstrate this aspect of the role within established abattoirs.

- Understands different cutting methods and be able to adhere to customer specifications
