

Maintenance Engineer – Beef Processing Abattoir

About the Employer

Kimberley Meat Company is an Australian owned beef abattoir supplying domestic and international markets from our Kimberley based plant. The plant is located approximately 110km east of Broome WA and has a daily throughput of approximately 300 head per day. Maintenance is carried out by a small and motivated team to ensure uninterrupted operations.

About the Role

As an experienced and skilled Plant Engineering with a beef processing background, you will work hands on with a small team and have the ability to manage and complete your tasks quickly. You will be responsible for the planning and scheduling of plant & equipment services of all the abattoir tools and equipment, fault finding and preventative maintenance system. Some overtime and weekend work will be required.

Key responsibilities will include:

- Maintain a high level of housekeeping in the workshop and yard areas
- Managing and ensuring the effective operations of Ammonia refrigeration plant including alarm monitoring and response 24hr/ day.
- Schedule and implement a preventative maintenance plan, including carrying of spare parts.
- Follow documented maintenance procedures and instructions
- Ensure maintenance reports are maintained for tools & equipment being serviced
- Maintaining equipment documentation and manuals
- Fault finding and troubleshooting to limit downtime and improve the operational effectiveness
- Assist in identifying and implementing maintenance opportunities for improvements
- Installation /relocation of existing and new equipment where and when required
- Ensuring Work health and safety guidelines are followed/compliant

To be successful for this role you must have the following:

- A minimum 5 years' experience in a similar role, preferably electrical fitter or the like
- Ability to read and interpret technical drawings and relevant information
- Current Drivers Licence
- Excellent problem solving and troubleshooting ability
- Strong communication skills, both written and verbal
