We comprise two cattle properties, including Centre Pivot Irrigation complexes on Wallal Downs Station based on the West Coast. We run approximately 30,000 head across the two properties and irrigate and cut hay from the centre pivot operations. We have a large array of modern machinery, plant and facilities. We use motorbikes at all times.

The successful applicants must have experience, able to think for themselves and be self-motivated, be neat and tidy, and be a happy and outgoing person.

All Accommodation and Meals are provided and we pay an attractive day rate. There is Single, Couple and Family Accommodation available. These positions are suitable for a single person or a couple. For the 2020 Season we require –

- Mechanic Experience with light vehicles, trucks, loaders, graders and Roadtrains is preferable with some on the job training available. Most of your work will be performed in the station workshop, but on occasions you will be required to use a station vehicle to attend to machinery out in the paddock. We have an extensive workshop, which also boasts a vehicle hoist and pit.
- Head Stockperson to lead a team of eight persons, and support the General Manager
 in the day to day station activities. We require someone who is driven, capable and
 energetic. You will need to be able to work unsupervised, capable on two-wheel
 motorbikes and experienced in low stress stock handling.
- Ringers to work in our eight person Stockcamp, undertaking all facets of cattle handling, fencing and station work. If you are willing to learn, then we are willing to teach you!
