Cunningham Cattle Company is seeking the following positions for the 2020 season to join the team at Esmeralda Station (400,000 ha). Esmeralda is located 110km South of Croydon and 280km North of Richmond. You will become a member of a large extended family. These positions will commence in February/March 2020.

Head Stockman – Full-time permanent position. The salary will be negotiated with the successful candidate based on skills and experience.

To be successful as our Head Stockman, the candidate will need to be capable of performing the following duties;

- Previous experience as a Head Stockman of a beef cattle operation (mustering, drafting, processing and trucking).
- Low stress livestock handling techniques and promote and manage best practice animal welfare for our animals.
