The position is available for commencement in January 2020.

Durham Downs Station is situated in the Channel Country of South West Queensland. The property spans 8,910 km² and runs approximately 17,000 head of cattle.

Reporting to the Station Manager, your main responsibilities will include aerial stock mustering, checking of stock and facilities and flying company staff between properties. You will at all times adhere to regulatory requirements and the company's safety and operational standards.

When not engaged in aerial operations, the successful applicant will be required to work as a Station Hand and assist with general day-to-day station activities including working with livestock.

- Hold an Australian Commercial Pilots Licence with aircraft class rating for Single-engine Aeroplane (SEA)
- Minimum 300 hours total time
- Minimum 100 hours of Pilot in Command (PIC)
- Low-level rating and Aerial Mustering endorsement *
- Experience flying a C172
- Current Class 1 medical
- Current Aviation Security Identification Card (ASIC)
- Current Class C Motor Vehicle Drivers Licence or higher class
- Right to live and work in Australia

* Training to obtain a low-level rating and aerial mustering endorsement will be provided to the successfully employed candidate if not already held.

Desirable Experience

- Previous Station Hand experience (on-ground mustering and livestock handling skills)
- Remote and regional area aviation experience as a single pilot.
