As an operator/truck driver your role is to contribute to the success of the Station. Your work will involve maintaining the vehicles/machinery you operate and daily inspections of machinery. Camping out is sometimes required, own camper is a bonus but not essential. Having good operating knowledge of CAT, MACKs and Kenworth trucks are essential. If you are hardworking and a team player, you will fit right into the team. Reporting to the Manager, you'll be a positive member of the crew.

Your role exists to make our business better. On any given day this could include, but is not limited to:

- Maintaining all machinery and trucks that you operate. This includes greasing the machinery prior to use.
- Daily inspections check before using the trucks/machinery
- Operating machinery including a Grader all over the station
- Driving cattle trucks

Physical demands of the role

- This job can be physically strenuous from time to time. You will be expected to be able to walk, climb, bend, kneel, lift, grip, grasp, push and pull various tools and equipment.
- This job requires the ability to comprehend written and oral operational and safety instructions and related rules, policies and memos, and to communicate clearly with your co-workers and supervisors.
