The yarding at CQLX Gracemere sale increased by 305 to 3,905 head with a mixed offering in some classes, although the vealer and light yearling cattle were a very good quality offering. Cattle were again drawn from most parts of Central Queensland, with a few more of the coastal cattle showing the effects of a receding season. The usual processors were present along with a strong restocker group. Competition was good throughout the sale, and prices regained the losses experienced the previous week.

Steer calves sold to 443c, to return mixed sex averages of 431c/kg for a good sample. Vealer steers sold to 459c to average 427c/kg. Vealer heifers reached 377c, with a large sample averaging 364c/kg. Yearling steers topped at 421c for light weights, with averages from 360c to 393c/kg across all weight rangers. Yearling heifers to feed topped at 347c, to average from 318c to 336c/kg. Those to the trade made to 359c, whilst restockers paid to 377c to average from 328c to 335c/kg.

Grown steers to feed averaged from 361c to 371c with sales to 379c, and processors lines averaged from 312c to 320c/kg. The best presented grown heifers sold to restockers to 359c, averaging from 321c to 328c, while feeders averaged from 313c to 328c/kg. Grown heifers to processors made to 337c, with a large sample averaging 321c/kg. The 2 score cows to restockers made to 278c, to average 263c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score cows saw prices to 308c, to average 292c/kg. Heavy bulls to processors averaged 296c/kg. Cows and calves topped at \$2,125 per unit for the better bred classes, and made from \$1,275 per unit.
