

Two new positions have become available for a couple on Cobungra Station, Victoria. This is a great opportunity to work within a close-knit group of people dedicated to producing high quality beef in a pristine environment. Cobungra Station is in a period of growth and expansion. These positions are newly created and will be integral to the running of the property.

Both positions are full time and will require some weekend work on a roster basis. More information on each position is below.

## **MACHINERY OPERATOR**

You must be able to operate a bulldozer and tractor. Experience with pasture renovation is essential as an extensive pasture program is to be undertaken and this will form the basis of the position. A D6 bulldozer is onsite and is used for various tasks on the property such as brushing tracks, pushing up fallen timber, etc. The expectation is that in down time you will undertake stock work, so stock handling experience is a must.

## **STOCK PERSON**

You will have a high level of horsemanship, along with your own horses and equipment. You will also need experience in low stress stock handling (or the desire to adhere to the principles of low stress stock handling); experience with AI, ET and calving cows; an eye for detail; and outstanding record keeping skills. Computer literacy and familiarity with technology is also necessary.

Both positions require the following:

- The ability to work within a team and alone
- Adhere to and cultivate a working environment based on safe working practices and WHS
- A desire to show ownership in the position, general interest in the company and a love of the beef industry in general.
