

Feed and Commodities Supervisor

Applications are open for a **Feed and Commodities Supervisor** at WestBeef Feedlot, a property operated by the Harmony Agriculture and Food Company, located 270 km north west of Perth and 7 kms south of the township of Kalannie in WA. The feedlot has a capacity of 5500 head of cattle with a primary focus on custom feeding and as a pre export quarantine facility.

The business is seeking a motivated and enthusiastic person to join the Feedlot team in a full-time capacity managing livestock feeding and commodity handling.

The Feed and Commodities Supervisor will report to the Feedlot Manager whilst having significant autonomy to execute the agreed feeding strategies of West Beef Feedlot.

Key Responsibilities

The Feed and Commodities Supervisor will be responsible for;

- Performing day-to-day tasks associated with the feeding and watering of livestock on the feedlot as directed by the Feedlot Manager, including to perform bunk checks, consumption assessments and mixing required feed rations for various feeding programs and delivering feed to bunk. Operation and maintenance, servicing and cleanliness of the West Beef Feedlot feed mill, plant and equipment and commodity storage area.
- Ensure that all feed commodity receivals, and all production and distribution of feedstuffs is accurately documented and input into the relevant recording system software such as Bunk Management System.
- Working with the Feedlot Manager in setting daily feeding staff rosters and training.

Preferable Qualifications Required

- A clear willingness to be involved in the cattle feedlot industry with proven initiative and leadership capacity
- A basic understanding of cattle ruminant nutrition especially relating to grain feeding of cattle. Formal training or qualification in this area would be viewed favourably.
- Sound and demonstrable computer skills and time management
- Drivers license (Some heavy machinery experience preferred but not essential)
- Understanding occupational health and safety hazards within your area of supervision and ensuring that these are managed accordingly.
