Responsibilities and skills required:

- Demonstrated experience in monitoring cattle health with the ability to diagnose animal health systems and treat with the appropriate protocols;
- Ensure animals are managed and handled in a humane manner and using appropriate cattle handling techniques;
- Follow animal welfare, quality and safety standards at all times as well as operating procedures and work instructions;
- Provide training to staff and contractors in cattle movements and processing activities;
- Lead, perform and organise staff and contractors to ensure all cattle movements and processing activities are completed in the areas of cattle receipt/unloading; cattle dispatch/loading; cattle induction and re-implant; maintenance and housekeeping; and cleaning water troughs;
- Proven livestock handling skills, and experience in vaccinating, tagging and drenching cattle;
- Experience in feedlot activities and being mechanically minded would be an advantage;
- Strong communication skills and the ability to lead effectively in a team, contributing positively to team operations and working relationships;
- Flexibility to work within a roster, along with data recordings skills and a knowledge of computers, and previous experience using stock-aid software is essential; and
