The property

The 750,000 acre property is a mix of gidgee, buffel grass, sandhill and spinifex country. The 5000 breeders are predominantly Santa Gertrudis. There are 25 bores and 14 sets of yards in use.

The role

The successful applicants would be expected to work with the Tarlton Downs Station manager. General duties include bore runs and water maintenance, fencing, machinery work, yard work, maintaining the health and welfare of livestock, mustering and other day to day station tasks.

Ideally this role would be suited to a young couple or junior station hands wanting to work within a family environment.
