In this role you will be responsible for the day-to-day management of the property, enabling the station to achieve maximum sustainable production and superior breeding. This exciting position would suit an applicant with leadership experience who is looking to enhance their skills in a hands-on role.

About "Alice Downs"

Alice Downs consists of 5 adjoining properties run as a single aggregation over 93,000 acres. The country type is predominantly black soil Mitchell Grass (interspersed with Buffell grass on the ridges) and sandy Buffell grass country. The average rainfall is 20 inches. The properties are currently running 3,000 head of cattle – we are in drought and drought declared.

There are two commercial breeder herds producing yearling steers and surplus heifers. Steers and heifers are sold via the Blackall saleyards and AuctionsPlus, depending on the season and the market.

The Forest Park Santa Gertrudis Stud sells approximately 70 bulls annually through the Barcoo Breeders Sale in October and paddock sales all year round. Bulls are sold to western, southern inland and north west Queensland and also transferred across to the commercial herd.

There is a small flock of sheep bred for meat.

The station has three permanent staff (including the Manager). Local casual staff are also used during peak mustering times and two experienced family members also help out when required. Mustering is done with motorbikes. A helicopter is used for the three large timbered paddocks. Horses are used for stud cattle mothering up and mustering bulls.

There are two sets of cattle yards, laneways and two shearing sheds. Machinery includes a truck, tipper, grader, front end loader, two station vehicles and 2/4-wheel motorbikes. Water is provided by a mixture of open dams, poly pipe and open flowing bore drains

The Alice Downs homestead is a large low set house set amongst an established garden. "Alice Downs" was made famous by blade shearer Jackie Howe when he set a world record by shearing 321 sheep in seven hours and 40 minutes on the property in 1892.

Working dogs are allowed and are primarily used for handling weaners in the yards and working bulls. Due to issues with wild dogs/dingoes, working dogs are not usually used for mustering.
