Location

Molesworth Station is located 60kms West of Richmond, Qld (on the Flinders Highway) and 10km north of Maxwelton. It is 40,000 acres and used for fattening and back grounding around 3000 of Brahman steers per year.

Job Description

This offering is a joint position and would suit a family or couple with great attention to detail, who take great pride in their work and who are looking for a good work life balance in an area with a great community to settle in to.

The primary position available is full time General Station Manager of the beef cattle property who would be responsible for the carrying out everyday running and maintenance of a fattening property and looking after the welfare of the animals. The role is an independent and autonomous one on a day to day basis. Reporting directly to the owner regularly and working in a small team when mustering is required.

The secondary position is for a part time Fulfillment Manager for and online clothing business which is based on the property. It would include packaging all online orders and keeping accurate records of inventory as well as carrying out general warehouse operations. This role is flexible and does not require any experience. It does however require the ability to work reliably and consistently an average of 2 days per week. It also has the potential to expand long term into other areas of the business for the right candidate if desired.

General Station Manager

- This role will include, but will not be limited to:

- Weekly water runs and water maintenance (tanks, troughs, poly pipes)
- Perform general maintenance as required and report any major repairs needed
- Implement capital improvements to the property including fencing, yard building, installing troughs & tanks, assisting with completion of new buildings, laying new poly lines etc.
- Mow, water and improve lawn areas within the station complex and maintain gardens (planting, pruning, weeding, mulching, watering)

- Report effectively on grass and cattle conditions on a regular basis
- Carry out improvements to the homestead complex where needed
- Administer supplements and monitor well being of animals
- Steel fabrication welding repairs
- Muster on motorbikes and process cattle
- Plan daily and weekly routines effectively
- Tractor and machinery operations
- Chemical weed and pest control
