Wylarah is located in the Central Queensland group, 15 km from Surat, the nearest service town, and 450km west of Brisbane, Queensland. Wylarah's purpose is the breeding of the Westholme Wagyu herd to produce full blood bulls for the AACo commercial herds, and to produce feeder steers. The property also breeds elite animals for the multiplier composite herds in the north, and acts as a backgrounding property for commercial Wagyu destined for Aronui Feedlot, Dalby.

General Maintenance Hand

To be successful in the role of General Maintenance Hand, you will be an all-rounder who can be utilized across both our Station and Farm operations. In this role you would be competent in fixing waters, driving tractors, grading and general station maintenance.

You will also have excellent communication skills and the ability to work as part of a team. Ideally you will have well developed practical experience and skills with experience in machinery maintenance and repairs, including welding and fabrication. **Duties & responsibilities aligned to this role may include;**

- Complete water harvesting operations, and flood irrigation activities



- Machinery operation relating to all aspects of dryland and irrigated crop production
- Maintain, clean and repair plant & equipment, and property infrastructure
- Perform routine daily checks & services on plant and equipment

Requirements (preferrable but not essential)

- HR truck license
- Excavator and grader experience
- Organised in work planning, and ability to work cooperatively with others

Cook/Domestic/Gardener

In the position of Cook/Domestic/Gardener at Wylarah Station, you hold a critical role in maintaining the overall presentation of the homestead grounds as well as the cleanliness of the stations living quarters, ensuring staff and visitors have an excellent experience throughout their stay. Whilst majority of your day will be aligned to gardening, cooking and domestic tasks, you may also be required to assist the Station Operations Officer with further admin duties aligned to your abilities.

To be successful in this role, you will need to have a good command of the English language, as well as experience in domestic and gardening duties. Attention to detail will be a plus, as well as the ability to manage multiple priorities at once.
