

## Detailed Saleyard Report - Cattle Market information provided by MLA's National Livestock Reporting Service

Despite the looming Easter holiday break numbers dipped. There was a limited selection of trade cattle and a reduction in heavy export stock. Competition was solid pushed along by major feedlot demand. The usual contingent of domestic and export processors were in attendance, although not all operated fully. There was more competition from feeder buyers while restockers battled hard to find lighter weight well-bred stock

In the trade market quality was very good but supply was limited. Trade heifers sold to stronger demand causing some big price variances at times for the end article. The bulk of the heifers to the trade sold 8c dearer making from 388c to 455c/kg. Trade steers were few and feedlots constantly outperformed domestic processor for all types of steers. Trade steers gained 17c to average 450c/kg. Heifers retuning to the paddock sold to a top price of 544c or the equivalent of \$1,452/head. Secondary weaner steer quality slipped, with some restockers selective when trying to purchase lines of well-bred stock. The bulk of the steers under 330kg sold from 476c to 660c/kg. The pick of the light weight steers averaged \$1,464 per head.

There was stronger competition for feeder steers 400 to 500kg with prices 7c higher to average 461c/kg. Steers 500 to 600kg met intense bidding from feedlots with the bulk selling from 410c to 451c/kg. Feeder heifers sold to a smaller group of buyers and well-bred stock were not as plentiful. Heifers 330 to 400kg recorded a top price of 460c with the average sitting at 432c/kg.

Not all processors operated in the export run. Bullock prices lifted 9c to average 385c/kg. Heavy C3 steers sold 9c dearer making from 360c to 414c/kg. Heavy heifers were in reasonable numbers and quality was quite mixed. C4 heifers sold from 342c to 385c/kg. Feedlots dominated sales across four year old lines paying from 370c to 415c/kg.

In the cow market not, all processors operated, and prices were very strong. Heavy well finished cows gained 9c making from 308c to 330c/kg.
