The role

A strong initiative to identify and document problems affecting production systems and implement strategies to reduce these issues, especially breakdowns, would also be an advantage.

Key responsibilities

- · Scheduling and performing maintenance on plant IT assets
- Installation, updating/patching, and configuration of software on workstations and some servers
- \cdot Administration of users, computers, and groups within Active Directory
- \cdot Asset management of devices and software
- \cdot Developing effective relationships with all relevant internal and external stakeholders
- Appropriately escalating issues to group IT support team while maintaining ownership of issue on site

Ideally you have

- Experience with hypervisors
- Experience with basic networking and basic routing, TCP/IP, IPv4, static routes
- Experience with complex DNS setups
- Experience with SQL and databases, but not necessary
- Previous experience in a factory/manufacturer setting
