This role will be responsible for the development of the daily production plan as well as providing support to the Commercial Team. This role would suit an experienced demand/supply planner who has worked in a similar position within Meat Primary Processing.

Key Accountabilities:

- Manage daily production plans and publish to relevant commercial staff members to ensure customer demands are upheld
- Analyse forecasted production plans against performance and address variances
- Conduct stock reviews and daily checks to ensure appropriate stock levels are maintained and coordinate stock replenishment
- Assist our Logistics Team with forward loading projections
- Planning and forward requirements with key stakeholders on raw material volumes
- Produce end of day target reports, identifying variances and identifying root cause for missed production, implementing actions
- Manage production schedule to prioritise requirements to ensure that production meets delivery time-frames.
- Manage a component of our Yield plans and our item specifications
- Provide detailed analysis and reporting on production performance, including forecasted production volumes to achieved volumes
- Communicate any supply issues to the commercial teams
- Review forecast accuracy to ensure safety stock levels are at the most effective levels
- Timely and accurate submission of reports to senior stakeholders within the business.
