

“Olinda Park” Feedlot Manager

Located 60km west of Dalby. The purpose of this role is to lead the routine care and feeding of cattle kept in the feedlot environment and oversee the operational process of the entire yard.

Responsibilities:

General Cattle handling

- Receiving of cattle;
- Animal handling and treatment;
- Draft out any sick animals;
- On dispatch count cattle from feed pens and to dispatch pens

Induction

- Inducting cattle into the feedlot;
- Move cattle through yard to crush for individual processing;
- Operate hydraulic crush and gates;
- Install ear tags, administer injections in neck of animal, band tails, check teeth, back line;
- Information collection recording all identification, weight and treatment for all cattle inducted;
- Count and move cattle to feed pens
- Experience with Tru-Test or similar weighing software
- Experience with computers and electronic devices used in the induction and dispatching process

Animal Health

- Diagnosing, identification, collecting information, administration of animal health treatment

General Feedlot Duties

- Cleaning and maintenance;
- Recording animal treatments and stock movements;
- Inventory control and stocktaking;
- Greasing/maintaining crush and gates, clean troughs;
- Workplace Health and Safety and Animal Safety compliance;
- Ration supervision;
- Preparation for trucking cattle;
- Safe chemical use and storage

Machinery Operation and Maintenance

- Operating loaders and tractors
- Vehicle and facility maintenance

Reporting

- Familiarity with Bunk Management System (BMS) program or similar;
- Commodity, feedbunk and animal movement management
