The Key responsibilities will include:

- Extract data from highly developed internal and external sources to deliver insightful and innovative crush strategies and solutions.
- Develop robust processes, procedures and forward plans relating to effective execution of the three commodities of canola seed, meal and oil.
- Identify arbitrage opportunities in freight, storage and the sale or purchase of commodities.
- Analyse commodity data which may include physical and derivative analysis, supply, and demand information.
