The Position

The position we have available is full time (38 hrs/week) Monday to Friday with no scheduled weekend work. You would be working primarily in a professional purpose-built office environment.

While you will enjoy a high degree of autonomy, you will also be well supported by the Centre's management team, production lab technicians, morphologists, administration, and dispatch.

You will work closely with our Export Animal Health Testing Officer who is responsible for scheduling, monitoring, and recording health testing requirements and results for export production.
