#### The Company

Congi covers nearly 11,000 HA and runs the largest superfine wool flock in Australia. There is also a breeding herd of 1500 cows which is run in conjunction with a beef fattening enterprise at Doughboy Mountain, Ebor. A team of 10 dedicated staff work across the two properties.

#### **The Position**

The role takes full ownership of the management, planning and day to day running of a complex fine wool, beef and seedstock enterprise. It leads the production planning, program management, fodder cropping and grazing management of both properties. It oversees the merino seedstock and genomics programs as well as the database management of over 16,000 MA indexed ewes as well as managing and monitoring supply chain accreditation schemes.

Reporting to the Managing Director, the role is responsible for the ongoing implementation and application of industry best practice WH&S policies and procedures. It leads the ongoing staff training and development initiatives and provides excellent staff management and leadership across the business.

- Timely/accurate budgeting and reporting;
