

## Detailed Saleyard Report - Cattle Market information provided by MLA's National Livestock Reporting Service

Numbers remained low after more than 100ml across the supply area There was only a limited selection of trade heifers offered. Heavy export numbers were few. The balance of the stock were secondary types suiting lot feeders, back grounders and restockers. Not all the regular export or domestic processors were in a attendance. There were very few feedlot orders in play, with most buyers travelling south to store sales in Victoria and South Australia.

Trade cattle supplies remain limited, and domestic processors struggled to find the correct types. Trade heifers sold to little competition selling at 520c to 538c/kg. Well-bred steers 280-330kg returning to the paddock were in limited supply selling from 555c to 625c/kg to average \$1894/head. The heifer portion sold from 450c to 725c/kg.

The feeder market operated over a considerable portion of the offering however, there were very few buyers in attendance. Price for lighter weight steers 330kg to 400kg averaged 547c/kg. Quality lines of well-bred secondary heifers 400 to 500kg met weak competition making from 530c to 538c/kg.

Bullock supplies were limited, and quality was excellent. The bulk of the bullocks selling at 336c to 420c/kg. Heavy heifers were in short supply, with the better shapes selling from 400c to 480c/kg.

In the cow market a small group of buyers operated the better finished cows sold to weaker demand averaging 343c/kg. Leaner medium weight types were in short supply. The D3 medium weight cows sold from 320 to 346c/kg.
