The Company

- Wollemi Farms: a portfolio of permanent crops and water assets in Northern NSW and Qld.

The Role

There is an exciting opportunity to join the Gunn Agri Partners team, as we are seeking an experienced and highly motivated Work Health & Safety Manager. This position is a newly created position due to business growth. This role will ideally be based at our support office in Bondi Junction or consideration will be given to working at home from a regional location, ideally close to our properties. There will be regular travel required to the farms to undertake this role.

This position has a dual reporting line to the General Manager - Operations and General Manager – Cattle and will provide specialist advice, guidance and leadership to ensure robust WHS management systems and processes within GAP managed businesses. This position is responsible for supporting management in the day-to-day WHS activities across all farming operations, including overseeing employee injury management and return to work programs. A key aspect is in partnering with our farm managers in identifying health and safety issues to ensure a safe workplace, and to reduce employee lost time as well as fostering the importance of a strong safety culture within the GAP family of businesses.

In particular your duties will include but not limited to: -

- Providing advice on a range of specialist WHS areas and ensuring that all regulatory requirements are understood by Managers and staff and are adhered to.
- Carrying out regular compliance audits across all farms against the internal framework and managing the external audit process.
- Leading in-house training with Managers and employees about health and safety issues and risk management.



- Ensuring GAP is informed of new legislation and maintaining a working knowledge of all Work Health and Safety legislation impacting on the agriculture sector.
- Ensure incidents are formally investigated and corrective actions are developed, implemented and reviewed for effectiveness.
- Co-ordinate the implementation GAP's WHS Management system with the acquisition of each new asset.
- Work closely in partnership with the Farm Managers and their respective Safety Groups to ensure that safety is given the highest priority and that these groups function properly and regularly.
- Develop and maintain effective "Return to Work" strategies and where necessary, work closely with staff, insurance providers, medical practitioners and others to efficiently manage Workers Compensation claims and other staff health related issues.
- Liaise with key stakeholders across the Gunn Agri Partners suite of businesses.
- Providing regular reporting to Managers, the board and regulatory bodies.

The Candidate

To be successful in the role you will need to demonstrate the following:

- Minimum 5-7 years Work Health and Safety experience.
- Knowledge of WHS legislation, standards and practices.
- High level proficiency in Microsoft office.
- Proven ability to build and maintain strong internal and external relationships.
- Self-starting and motivated, with ability to work to deadlines.
- Superior time management and prioritisation skills.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Strong team orientation and the ability to work autonomously.
- Current driver's licence and ability to undertake frequent travel.
