Four centre pivot irrigators have recently been installed for irrigated pasture to minimise the impact of drought.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to

- Record keeping

- Ensuring clean water troughs are always maintained.
- Receiving, processing and dispatch of cattle to and from the feedlot.
- Scanning, drafting cattle to market specifications and weighing of livestock. NLIS reading and weighing using modern equipment.
- All aspects of livestock husbandry and welfare including handling and veterinary treatments.
- Welfare checks for the identification and diagnosis of illnesses with efficient communication to the Farm Manager.
- Feed mixing & delivery.
- Cleaning feed bunks.
- General farming duties, with modern machinery, loader, telehandler, modern feed mixer and mill.
- Pasture renovation, fencing, welding, water and general property maintenance, irrigation, and general farm / feedlot duties.
- Ensure that livestock handling facilities are kept in a clean and tidy state.
