An exciting opportunity exists for experienced and highly motivated Cropping Overseers to join our team on either the Burmah Aggregation, near Inverell or the Nortongong/Crillee Aggregation, near Collie in NSW.

Property Descriptions:

- 1. The Burmah aggregation is a 6,365ha mixed enterprise farm made up of 2 properties (Burmah 5,135ha and The Glen 1,230ha) located within 60km from Inverell and approx. 400km to Brisbane. 3,212ha arable cropping area with scope for further cropping development based on land use selection in line with operational parameters.
- 2. The Nortongong/Crillee aggregation will start to crop approximately 9,000ha from 2024, with this position initially responsible for circa 3,000ha with a view to growth in the region. The farms are located approximately 30kms from Collie and 60kms from Dubbo.

The Cropping Overseer works alongside the Farm Manager in a hands-on approach to construct, plan and execute best practice broad acre summer and winter cropping programs. The incumbent has the responsibility for ensuring cropping operations are within the confines of the approved budget and will be accountable for the procurement of cropping inputs and inventory, along with the management of running the aggregations plant and equipment.

The position presents a rare opportunity for a Cropping Overseer or a Senior Farm Operator to launch themselves into a management position within a supportive team culture. This position offers further career opportunities within a fast-growing business upon demonstration of attitude, skills and ability.

To be successful in the role, you will need to demonstrate the following:

- Experience as a Cropping Overseer/Senior Operator on a large scale broadacre cropping operation.
- Sound knowledge and understanding of agronomy, timing and operations.



- Experience in machinery set up, calibrations, operations, trouble shooting and maintenance.
- Self-starting, high levels of accountability, motivation and ability to deliver to deadlines.
- Experience leading workers, including staff and contractors.
- Ability to capture and manage accurate data for business forecasting and budgeting through AgWorld and John Deere Ops Centre or other similar software.
