Role

Reporting directly to the Farm Manager, this 2IC role is responsible for all day-to-day operations across the >10,000 Ha aggregation. You will work with a dedicated team but have direct responsibility of irrigation management, from planning and implementation to maintenance and evaluation.

Responsibilities

- Design, implement, and manage irrigation schedules based on crop needs, weather conditions, and water availability.
- Monitor and maintain irrigation infrastructure, including pumps, pipes, and sprinkler systems, to ensure optimal functionality.
- Collaborate with the Farm Manager and other team members to develop waterefficient practices and improve irrigation efficiency.
- Conduct regular field inspections to assess crop moisture levels and adjust irrigation practices accordingly.
- Keep accurate records of water usage, irrigation schedules, and maintenance activities

- Proven experience in growing cotton
- Strong understanding of crop water requirements and irrigation systems
- Relevant qualifications in agriculture, horticulture, or a related field are desirable
- Ability to operate farm machinery and equipment
