- **Machinery Operation:** Operate and maintain a variety of farm machinery and equipment, ensuring optimal performance and safety.
- **Maintenance:** Perform routine maintenance and repairs on farm equipment, fencing, infrastructure and water trough reticulation.
- **Record Keeping:** Maintain accurate records of spraying, machinery usage, and maintenance activities.

Minimal travel will be required to the other properties. Being located away from the manager, the successful applicant will be required to work autonomously, maintaining high standards of animal welfare, pasture management, machinery upkeep and livestock records via Agriwebb.
