4. Maintain detailed records using Agriwebb and Stockbook
5. Ensure compliance with all relevant agricultural regulations and industry best practices
6. Work closely with the farm manager and other staff the overseer will play a key role in day-to-day operations to continually improve operational efficiency and profitability
7. Working across Monday-Friday with flexibility required a must for some rostered weekend work and during peak times, including for breeding programs and calving
